- Prioritized the MVP across virtual-credit predictions, voting, settlement, leaderboards, no-code administration, auditability, and monitoring. No real money was involved.
- Delivered the system with OpenAI Codex and no external development team: a working MVP in six hours and production in about one month of part-time work.
- Owned QA, security, release, and live operations: 2,917 event predictions settled across 11 events, 1,050 voting records, zero crashes or functional errors, and correct calculation of every result.
